<ul style="list-style-type: none">Support AFL Hunter Central Coast By-Laws at the Clubs "Recruitment and Retention, Auskick and Junior Policy" at all timesApply the code of conduct for coaching staff and players that supports the objectives of the Club on and off the field.Contact all current players as soon as practicable after the completion of the previous season to outline plans for the coming season.Provide recommendations to the Junior Football Co-ordinator on the recruitment of appropriate football support staff.Instruct the players placed under their care generally and to see that all players carry out sufficient training, this includes pre-season training. Sufficient training is considered to be a minimum of 1 x 60 min training session up to 2 x 90 min training sessions per week.Plan, organise and provide a variety of skills based, game simulation and fun activities at training sessions. Training sessions should be interesting and engaging.Provide positive motivation and feedback to help the kids understand the game of afl and how to play as a teamProvide game day coaching expertise.Give all kids a chance to play in all positions so the kids can experience all aspects of the game and find their positionPrioritise enjoyment and participation over winning.Attend twice yearly a meeting with Coaches Co-ordinator and other junior coaches to establish a consistent coaching policy throughout the Club.Follow and positively promote any club directives, including, but not limited to, team selections, training day and time, match day fixtures and club decisionsBe a positive Role Model for the club and the kids, especially when dealing with umpires, officials and opposition clubsAssist with junior development outside the Club where possible or appropriate.Attend Club functions as agreed toProvide regular reports as required throughout the season.
